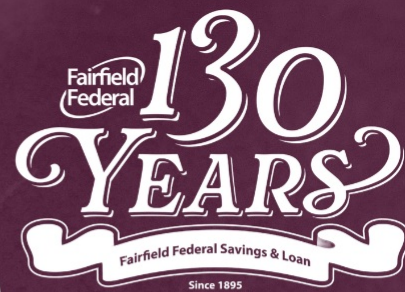
GRAND OPENING OF FAIRFIELD FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN
